Riverview Animal Clinic will board your pet in a kennel or run for the duration of its stay. We walk dogs at least twice daily, provide clean water, and feed Pedigree dry food twice daily based on weight. Cats get fed dry food free choice. We may give canned food to encourage your pet to eat. We provide blankets for your pets comfort and would prefer not to have your bedding so it does not get destroyed by urine or a bored pet. We also cannot allow toys smaller than 3 inches in diameter (the size of a tennis ball or smaller) because they can get lost in (and plug) our drain system. Your pet may get stress related diarrhea, which we may treat with food or medications at the discretion of our veterinarians. If an emergency situation arises we will try to contact your emergency contact listed below, but may initiate treatment at the discretion of our veterinarians. There may be a charge for these services.
