Your animal is scheduled for the above procedure today which involves general anesthesia. By signing, you give our doctors permission to receive, prescribe, operate or perform dental work on your pet.

Riverview Animal Clinic wants to provide the best possible health care for your pet. If we find ear mites, foreign bodies (usually in ear), fleas, or other problems that cause discomfort to your pet, we will treat these and you will be charged a fee for this procedure. Dental procedures may be more involved than simply removing tartar. If teeth are diseased, loose or damaged, they may be extracted. If antibiotics seem warranted for the procedure, we will give an injection and a prescription will be dispensed. There will be a charge for these services.

Riverview Animal Clinic is not staffed twenty-four hours a day and after hours treatment of patients is at the discretion of the veterinarian.

Pain Management:

We recommend pain management for all surgery/dental patients. However, due to the extra cost, it is optional for spay/neuter and minor procedures. The cost will assure you that your pet endures less pain in the recovery process. This is not optional for major surgeries including de-claws, ear crops and dental extractions. **Cost: Cat \$17.00 0-20# dog \$22.00**

Pre-Anesthetic Blood Testing:

We **highly** recommend a pre-anesthetic blood panel for all patients. This allows us to evaluate the liver and kidney, the main organs that metabolize the anesthesia. This also provides a baseline for later in life. Anesthetic is always a risk and this added precaution helps reduce this risk. **Cost: \$62.00**

IV Fluids:

Intravenous fluids during anesthesia keep blood pressure normal and speed recovery. We recommend fluids but due to additional cost, do not require it. **Cost: \$32.00**
